## GATE Seminar & Mock Test

Before the actual GATE test on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Scholastic Excellence is organising a preparation seminar and mock test workshop in February and March. The seminars focus on some of the most challenging aspects of the GATE tests – giving students tips on how to ace the tests in good time. The highlight is a mock test with full length papers comprising of the four GATE/ASET components tested under actual time conditions on the 20<sup>th</sup> Feb.

The workshop continues on 1<sup>st</sup> March (Monday – Labour Day Public Holiday) with a clear explanation of answers to each question and a sample writing response for writing as well as exam and time management tips.

The mock test consists of Reading Comprehension (35 minutes for 35 multiple choice questions), Writing (25 minutes), Quantitative Reasoning (35 minutes for 35 multiple choice questions) and Abstract/Non-verbal Reasoning (20 minutes for 35 multiple choice questions).

There will be a 15 minutes break after the Writing test and before the Quantitative Reasoning test.

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## Terms and Conditions

Enrolment of your child into the workshop indicates your agreement to the following Terms & Conditions:

(1) Students attend the workshop at their own risk.

Students are only allowed to bring in their schoolbag, stationery, pencil case, water bottle. No mobile phones or phones will be allowed at the workshop. All mobile phones will have to be left at the front of the room and collected after the test.

The format of the mock tests is similar to the actual GATE/ASET test, they are privately written and types of questions may differ from the actual tests.

(4) **Due to copyright reasons, students have to submit all test papers and answer sheets. None of these will be returned.**

(5) **No marked test papers will be sighted by parents. Results of your child will be communicated to you in terms of bands for each paper and an overall band.**

- There are 5 bands – Band 5 is the top 10% of students in terms of ranking, Band 4 is the next 20% of students, Band 3 is the next 30%, Band 2 is the next 20%, and Band 1 is the lowest 20%.
- The higher the band, the better the performance of your child.
- Ranking in the top band indicates a higher chance of your child to be successful in the GATE/ASET but this is not guaranteed.
- Similarly, a lower ranking does not definitely indicate failure of your child to be successful in the GATE/ASET test.
